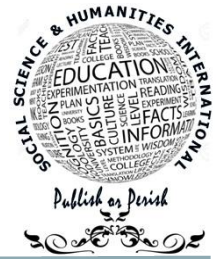

Trends in growth and composition of macro sectors of Jammu and Kashmir state: An analysis from 1995-2015

ABSTRACT

In present study an attempt has been made to analyse the empirical trend in growth and composition of macro sectors of Jammu and Kashmir State (1995-2015). This analysis has been done at all three macro sectorial levels as well as economy as a whole. After analysing this study, it gives us a clear picture and it becomes clear that agriculture sector growth rate is a dismal one while as the growth rate of the industry sector is the highest among all the sectors, but still that is not a satisfactory one. Moreover, our interpretation also reveals that tertiary sector is a dominating sector with respect to its percentage contribution to the state economy output.
